



Inteligencia artificial en salud: retos éticos y científicos (Artificial intelligence in health: ethical and scientific challenges)

This volume explores the impact of AI in our society and on the field of health in particular, where this technology is already being used. It's important to pause and critically assess its effects on individuals, going beyond its apparent technological advantages.







Donació de plasma i altruisme

A la Unitat Europea al voltant d'una 300.000 pacients depenen de medicaments derivats del plasma sanguini, majoritàriament per a tractar malalties rares que no tenen tractament tota la vida. En els darrers anys la demanda dels derivats del plasma ha crescut exponencialment, i això ha fet que el seu preu augmenti, també per les noves indicacions clíniques. Aquesta realitat l'oposa amb el fet que Europa no és, ni de lluny, «a excepció de França», un autentificant en plasma i més d'un 40% del total dels Estats Units, on es estàndards tècnics ben diferents dels nostres. Fins ara la normativa europea estableix que l'autorització de diversos components d'el·lipsis dels teixits i còlules, estableix taxativament que la donació de sang ha de ser voluntària i no remunerada, i no accepta cap compensació monetària, cosa que haurà (*los fundamentos gerais*), recollit també en el Convent Europeu de Bioètica (1997), s'hafomentat l'autorització a la importació de països en què l'obligació de la donació no existeix, també en un estricte concepte d'altruisme, que no contempla cap compensació monetària ni fins a la donació. Amb tot, hi ha alguns països que compensen en espècies com d'exemples, els Països Baixos, Alemanya, Itàlia, i que farem, i ho fan amb un important economic proporcional.

En el seu conjunt, sempre un model de no compensació, apostant a la solidaritat de la ciutadania, però també amb escasses resultats malgrat els esforços dels darrer anys. Des de fa temps, excepte en el seu desbastiment puntual i global d'hemodireràtivs en el context del covid-19, Europa ha quedat en la qüestió i està ultimant una nova normativa pactada amb els estats membres que preveu una alternativa entre la compensació dels donants, ja admetuda en altres tipus de teixits i còlules, i arribar per al plasma per incrementar-ne l'oferta. I, en el seu moment, amb el creixement laboral, socials, familiars i de salut a les quals el sistema no respon com caldrà.

Un model com el que planteja Europa, que vol solucionar el problema del plasma per als seus ciudadanos, vulnera el concepte d'altruisme i atempta contra la solidaritat de la ciutadania, i caldrà veure-ho amb oiles de futur en una societat a qui potser no podem demanar més sacrificis quam el gruix de la ciutadania, i que potser per això, i amb el creixement laboral, socials, familiars i de salut a les quals el sistema no respon com caldrà.

Aquest canvi ha fet sorgir tot un seguit de crítiques a diferents nivells, sovint
