Adela Cortina is director of the ETNOR Foundation, a member of the Spanish National Committee for Human Assisted Reproduction and a member of the Advisory Council at the Spanish Ministry of Health and Consumption. Since the year 2008 she is a member of the Royal Academy of Moral and Political Sciences. She works in the field of political philosophy and in matters of ethics relating to companies, politics and health service.

The conference addresses the role that ethics plays in the current economic environment. Adela Cortina believes that an economy without ethics is inhumane, and therefore a bad economy, because it leads to poverty and suffering instead of helping to create healthy societies, which ought to be its intention. The speech will provide an ethical focus on economic recession and will try to outline proposals for overcoming it, which have a direct repercussion people's health.
