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4th Josep Egozcue Cycle of Lectures

The Josep Egozcue cycle of lectures are now consolidated the Foundation's annual event with international expert speakers in bioethics. Guests at previous editions have included Daniel Callahan, Eric Cassell and Ruth Macklin, who have given their own ethical view on medical science. This year the guest speaker is Mark Siegler, professor of Medicine and director of the Maclean Center for Clinical Medical Ethics at the University of Chicago.

Siegler will speak on the doctor-patient relationship, by exploring how this has evolved throughout history from the traditional paternalistic approach to the modern day bureaucracy of the cost-benefit model. Despite the shifts and changes in model there has always been a close doctor-patient interaction. Ethics have contributed greatly in bringing about the more recent "shared decision making" model we know today. Both of the scheduled lectures will closely explore these and other aspects of the doctor-patient relationship.

Dr. Siegler has combined his medical practice with the study and diffusion of bioethics for more than 40 years. He is the author of various articles and books on bioethics, and is co-author of *Clinical Ethics: A Practical Approach to Ethical Decisions in Clinical Medicine*. This was also translated and published in Spanish under the title *Ética Clínica*, sponsored by the Victor Grifols i Lucas Foundation.
