VII Josep Egozcue Lecture Cycle

Josep Egozcue Lectures have consolidated as the Foundation's annual event with international experts in bioethics. Daniel Callahan, Eric Cassell, Ruth Macklin, Mark Siegler, Thomas Murray and Carol Gilligan were invited to the latest editions to offer their ethical point of view of life sciences. This year the Foundation invited Peter Singer, professor of Bioethics at Princeton University.

He is one of the most prestigious international philosophers. Some of his most well known books include *Practical Ethics*, a reference manual in applied ethics, and *Animal Liberation*, in which he vindicates animal rights and denies the belief that the human species is superior to others. He was the founding president of International Association of Bioethics and co-editor and co-founder of the publication *Bioethics*.

He is currently working on the project "the life you can save", an altruistic movement that combats extreme poverty. This movement argues that an ethical life involves the use of some of our wealth and resources to improve the lives of those less fortunate than ourselves.
